

SATISFACTORY/UNSATISFACTORY OPTION FORM

Students may take elective offerings on a Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory (S/U) basis. See *Academic Rules* IV.B.(3). Upon successful completion of such offering, the student shall receive a grade of Satisfactory (S). In the event that such an offering is not successfully completed (**achieves a grade below C minus**), the final grade shall be Unsatisfactory (U).

Correlation of S/U with letter grades. A Satisfactory grade shall carry no numerical equivalent and will not be counted in computing a student’s grade point average for purposes of eligibility for continuing as a degree candidate or qualifying for a degree. An Unsatisfactory equates to a grade of F, carries the numerical equivalent of zero, and shall be counted in computing a student’s grade point average for purposes of eligibility for continuing as a degree candidate or qualifying for a degree.

Exercise of S/U Option. Students must exercise their options to take courses on an S/U basis before the stated S/U date for each semester.

S/U Grading where letter grades are not feasible. Instructors may determine that letter-grades are not feasible. Students’ work will then be graded as Satisfactory or Unsatisfactory, or, at the instructor’s discretion, as Satisfactory (S), Unsatisfactory (U), or Outstanding (O). **NOTE: It will not be noted on the transcript which courses were offered on an S/U/O basis, an S/U basis or if students exercised their option to take a course S/U.**
