Required Sequencing*:

2nd Yr Fall: DWS Pretrial Practice (4); Personal Tax (3) = **(7 credits)**

2nd Yr Spring: DWS Trial Advocacy (3); DWS Miniseries (2); DWS Negotiations (2) = **(7 credits)**

By the End of 2nd Yr (Either Semester): Business Associations (3); Wills, Trusts, & Estates (3); Evidence (3); = (9 credits)

3rd Yr Fall: DWS Transactional Practice (3) = (3 credits)

3rd Yr Spring: DWS Advanced Litigation and Problem Solving (Capstone) (3) = (3 credits)

By the End of 3rd Yr: Clinic/Externship at least 6 hours total (including course work) (plus any prerequisites) (6) = (6 credits)
